Brief description of the Transnational cooperation:

1. Problems to be solved (justification of the need of the transnational cooperation)

UMiA (Young People's Mobilisation Towards work and Labour Market) is a project in which the Social Insurance Agency, Employment Agency, Municipalities, and health Sevices, along with user organisations and employers (Bussiness life), should have a consensus based on the individual needs and which players take joint responsibility for the entire process from a holistic approach. Consideration should be given to project participants' life situation, needs, motivations and circumstances. The target group is around 950 young men and women with disabilities. Many in the target group are people with psychiatric or neuropsychiatric disabilities. The project aims to give the target group more empowerment through more involvement in achieving higher employment / supply capability. To support, customization and collaboration they must support themselves and belive in their capacity to get a job. The project will operate in the north of Stockholm

2. Objectives to be achieved

- Barriers is today stopping people with disabilities from participating fully in society. One important barrier is how to enter the labor market. We would like to learn and share good experiences from other counties how to involve employers and business and how to extend the social economy.
- In order for all people with disabilities to be able to shape their own life's, general support needs to be complemented with customized support and service. We need to see the individual!
